NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL DRAINAGE WORKS A5 Witherley Road

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential drainage work to sections of Watling Street at Witherley.

After carrying out survey work in the area, works are proposed to reduce the risk of surface water from the A5 carriageway running onto private driveways and the footway.

The works involve replacing the existing kerbs, together with a linear drainage system across the driveways along the highway boundary. The existing footway is also to be resurfaced.

This design will act to mitigate any future carriageway flooding issues and improve road safety.

When will the work take place?

These works are now re-programmed to start on the **10**th **August 2022** to avoid clashes with other works on the network and is scheduled for completion by the middle of **October 2022**.

To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and to minimise disruption to the local community, residents, businesses and road users, we will work between **8pm** until **6am**.

Please note that all our planned works are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

How will the work affect businesses and residents?

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and customers, the majority of our works will be carried out under traffic signals.

However, some of the works will require a full closure of the eastbound carriageway as well as restricted access to Bridge Lane and Kennel Lane, which are currently scheduled for the last 2 weeks of the works ending early October, again we will be working week nights from **8pm** until **6am**.

During full road closures we will put in place signed diversion routes which have been agreed with the Local Authority.

How will the work affect businesses and residents?

To keep noise disturbance to a minimum, we will complete our noisiest work before midnight.

We will make sure that access to businesses and residences is maintained wherever possible.

The footpath (shared by pedestrians and cyclists) and some side roads will be closed during our overnight works. Access will also be provided where required, via traffic marshals.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.
